



## Greene woman is electrocuted at home

WAYNESBURG, Pa (UPI) — A Greene County woman was electrocuted helping her husband install a citizens band radio antenna, state police say.

The victim was identified as Brenda Marie Farabee, 21, of Franklin Township

Mrs. Farabee was helping her husband put up the antenna Saturday night when it touched some power lines 30 feet above the ground, state police said.

Mrs Farabee was pronounced dead at Greene County Memorial Hospital

Mr. Curtis Farabee had a family antenna party installing a CB antenna 14 July 1984. Tragically Farabee's wife 21 year old mother of two, Brenda Farabee (1963-1984) helping with the installation came in contact with high voltage and expired at the scene. The Farabee's had two children Curtis Lee Jr and Melissa. The Farabee's were members of the Jefferson Church of Nazarene. Per Valley Independent Monessen Pa 16 July 1983.

This sort of tragic accident happens all too frequently in the radio hobby. Down through the years hundreds of hobbyists have been killed or injured. I wonder if we are prepared to deal with these harmful incidents?
